Baptism: Please contact Deacon Bob (337) 278-7923 during early months of pregnancy. Baptism preparation is required.

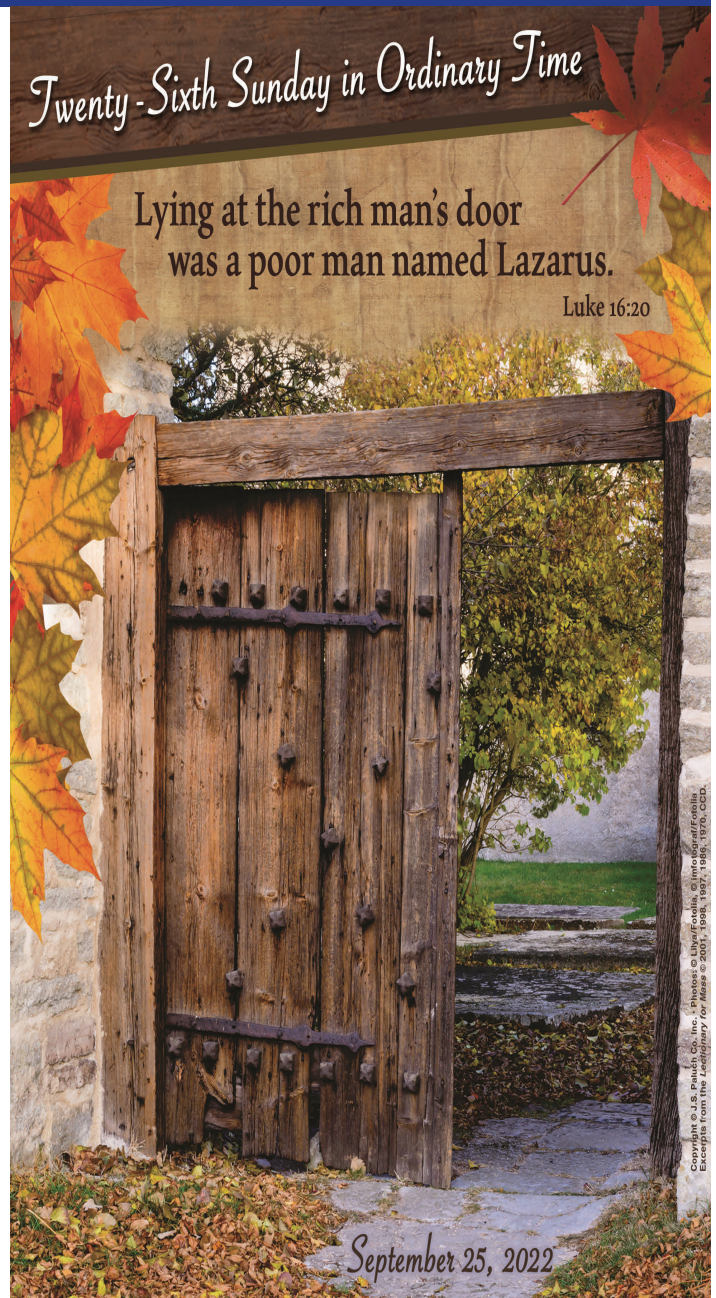

The second step is attending a mandatory Baptismal Preparation Seminar. Both parents and godparents are required to attend. The third, and final, step will be setting a date for the baptism to take place.
