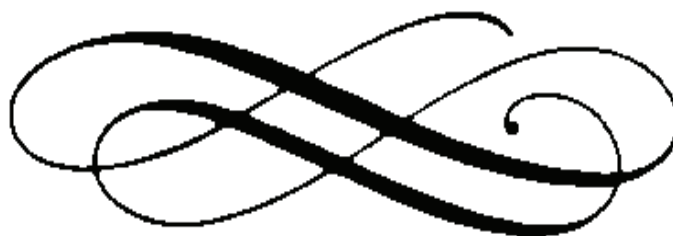

## **New Baptismal Program**

Moving forward, we will begin using a new three-step program for all baptisms. The first step required is meeting with Deacon Bob McDonner. The purpose of this meeting allows Deacon Bob to get better acquainted with the parents, explain baptismal procedure, complete all necessary paperwork and to address any questions the family may have. The second step is attending a mandatory Baptismal Preparation Seminar. Both parents and godparents are required to attend. The third, and final, step will be setting a date for the baptism to take place.
