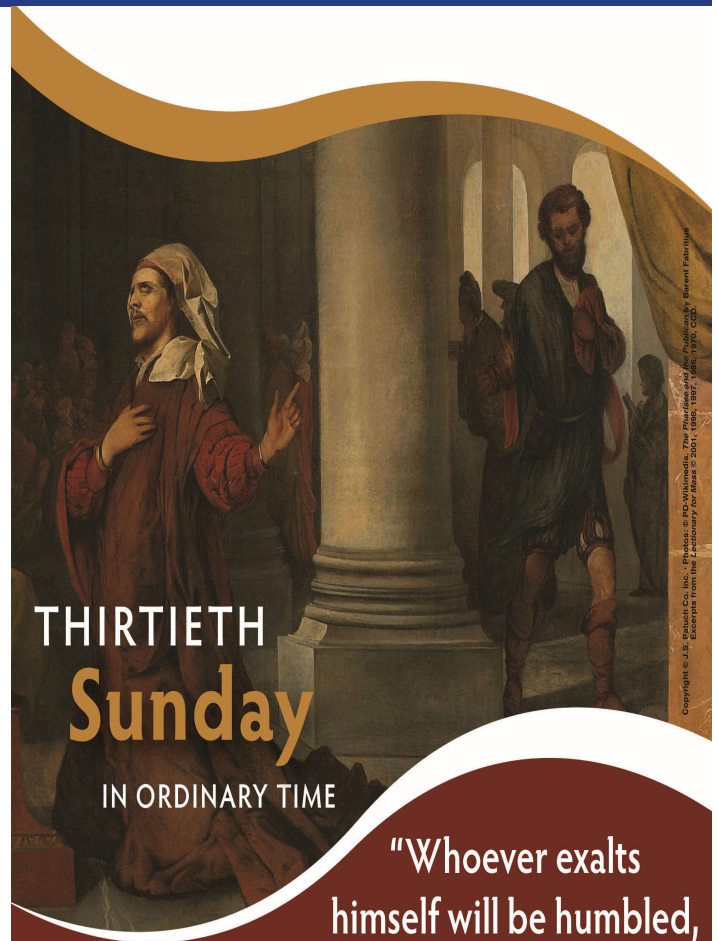

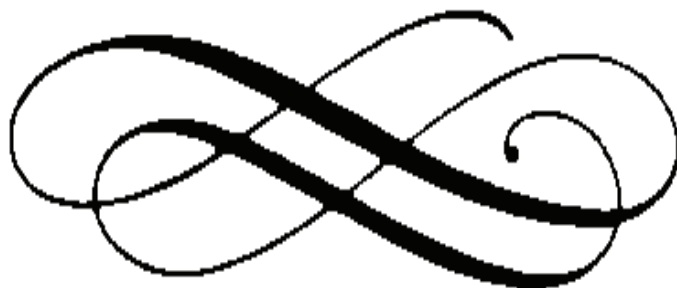
RCIA/RCIA-C
