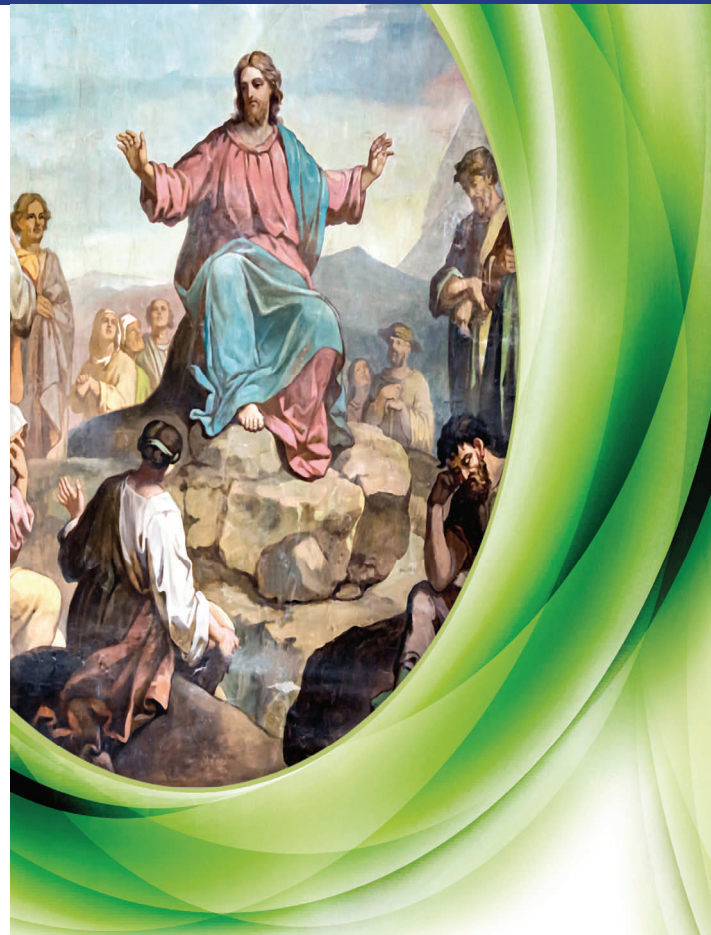

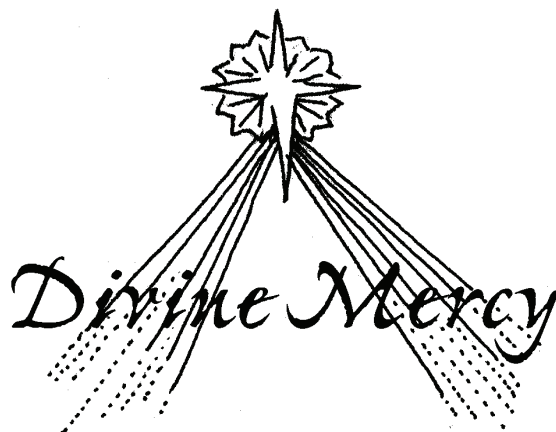
End Of The Year Statements
