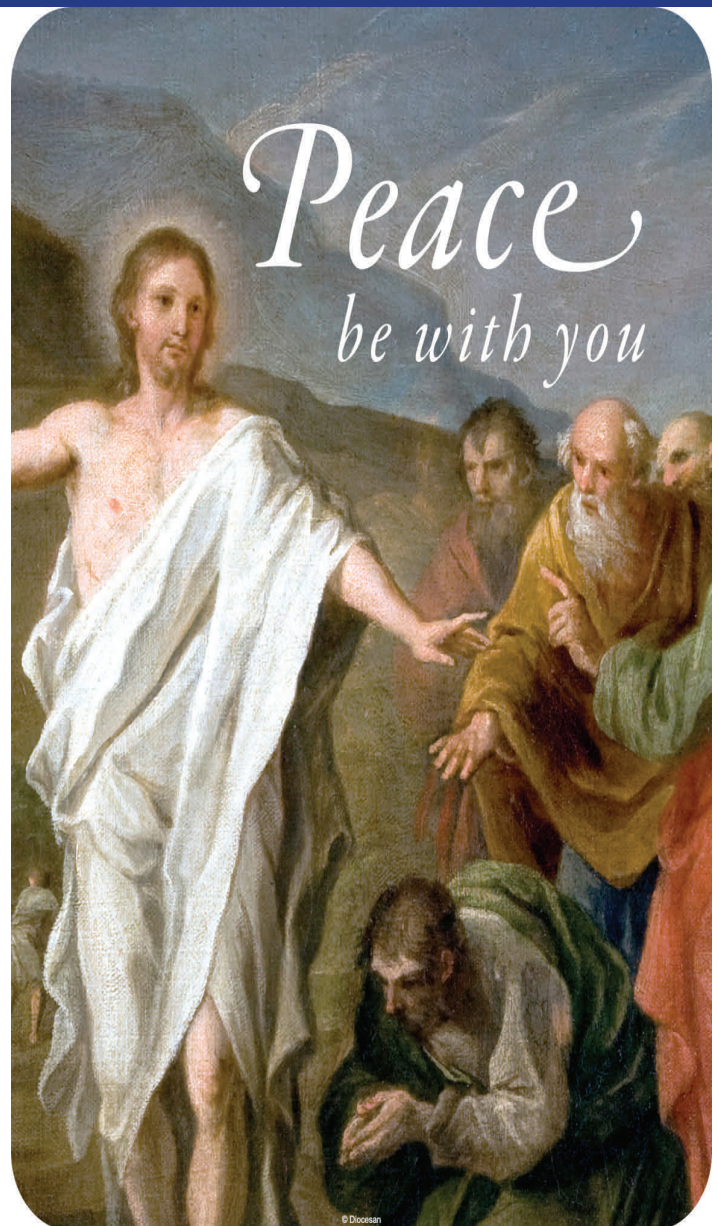

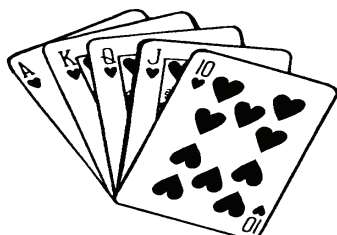
St. Vincent de Paul Fill a Prescription

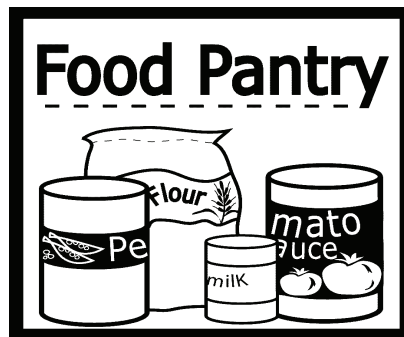
