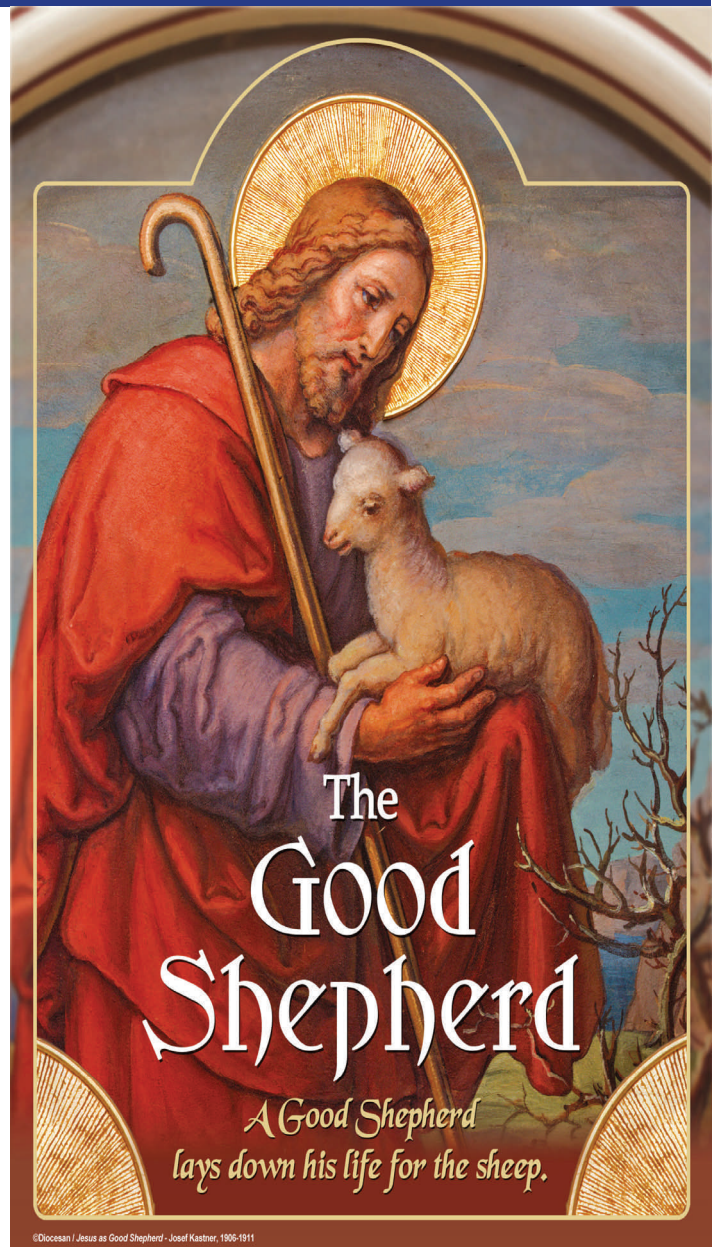

DIOBR Office of Life, Peace & Justice Petition to End the Death Penalty

The Office of Life, Peace, and Justice, in coordination with our Prison Ministry outreach, is conducting a campaign to ask Governor Landry to stop death penalty executions in Louisiana. Two more executions have been scheduled, the first one on May 28 of Darrell Draughn and the second one on June 4 of Marcus Reed. If nothing prevents them, these next executions will take place very soon after the first execution in our State in 15 years that took place on March 28 (the execution of Jessie Hoffman).

As Catholics who seek to build a culture of life, we cannot remain quiet. Because of the immediacy of these executions, we ask for your urgent support by joining our petition.
