The Diocese of Baton Rouge Child Nutrition Program is once again offering free summer meals to all children 18 and under on a first-come, first-served basis at 10 drive-through church sites in the diocese during the month of June. The grab-and-go meals are free, but **registration is required**. Registration information is available at cnpbr.org/summer-feeding-info. Participants must print the completed form and bring it with them to the pick-up site

Each student will receive a package containing 7 breakfasts and 7 lunches along with one gallon of milk. Meals will be distributed between **9:00AM** and **11:00AM** at various drive through sites. There is a limit of 5 meal packages per vehicle.
