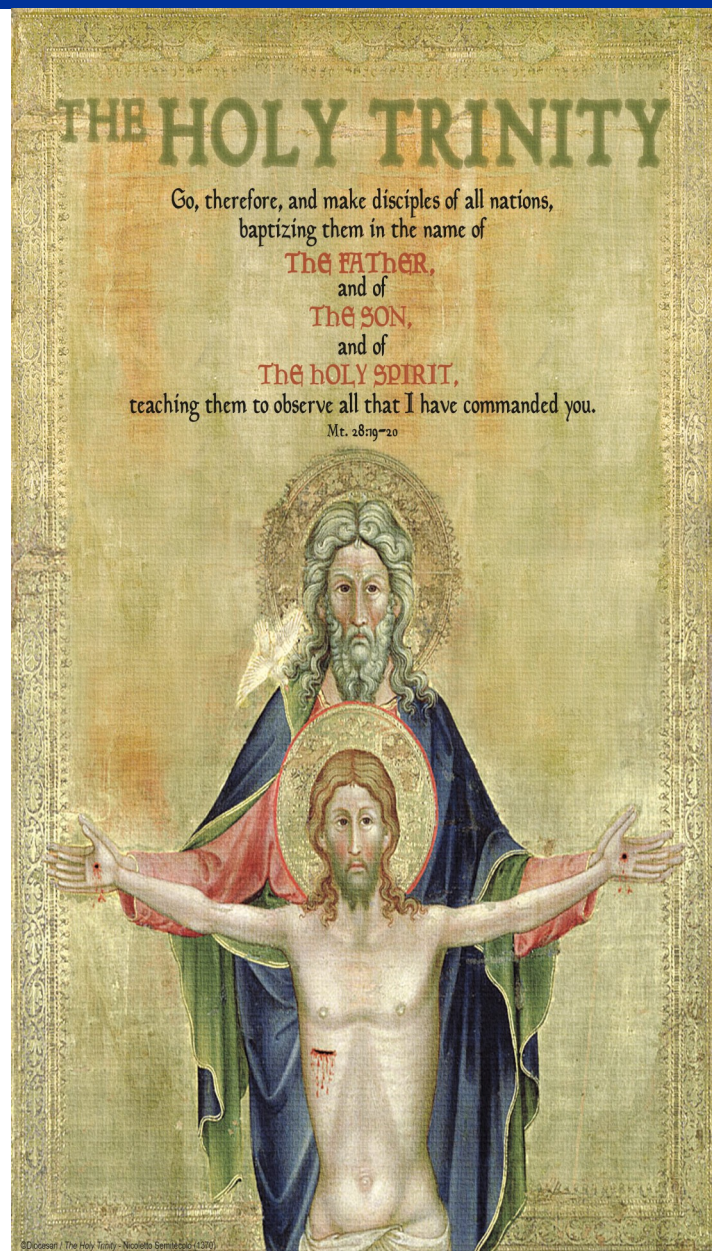

Sacrament of Confirmation

As many of you may know, Fr. Amrit announced Bishop Duca's decision regarding Confirmation. He has decided that Confirmation will now take place in the 7th grade, instead of the 11th grade. With that being said, it is necessary that we catch the students up. Our plans for Immaculate Conception are to confirm the 9th, 10th & 11th grades in 2026, 7th & 8th grades in 2027 and start confirming 7th grade in 2028.

Registration for 2025-2026 year is **July 22-24, 2025**, from **9:00 AM till 6:00 PM**, for grades 1st-11th, in the Office of Christian Formation. This includes students from Catholic Schools, as well as those that need to register for the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation.
