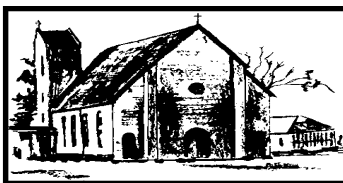

Easter greetings and happy Divine Mercy Sunday. As you know by now our parish fair, *Les Bon Vieux Temps Sur Le Chenal*, is next weekend. This “good ol’ time on the channel” will be celebrated on Saturday and Sunday. There will be a Mass at 10AM on Sunday at the fairgrounds. This will replace our 9 and 11AM Masses at the church. Please come out and enjoy yourself at the fair and celebrate Mass with us. And please pray for good weather!

Easter is a good time to celebrate our parish life with a fair. I’m especially thankful for all who helped with last week’s Easter liturgies, decorations, furnishing, vestments, sacramental prep and so much more. I look forward to a great celebration of our parish at the fair next weekend where even more volunteer workers are contributing.

This Sunday is Divine Mercy. Divine Mercy Sunday, the second Sunday of Easter, is a time when we especially remember the gift of God’s mercy offered to us through Christ. Our Lord himself chose a Polish nun, St. Faustina, to work to spread the message of his Divine Mercy in the first half of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. In her diary it is recorded that our Lord specifically asked for His Mercy to be preached and honored on this day. He said to the nun: **“The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.”** There is even a greater emphasis this year on God’s Divine Mercy thanks to our celebration of the Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy.

Mercy is everything to us as Christians. Without it all the other aspects of our faith would be pointless. It is God’s mercy which makes it possible for us to not only be forgiven for our sins, but even to do good and avoid sin. In fact, it is out of mercy that God has even allowed us to exist. On this Sunday and throughout this year I again encourage all of us to seek out Christ’s mercy by repenting of sin, embracing the new of life Christ in the Church, and going out into the world with the joyful message of Christ’s love.
