In Christ

This Wednesday, June 29<sup>th</sup>, is the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. These two men are the most important figures in the building up of the Christian Church. Images and statues of them are seen in almost every Catholic Church. They are both honored in our stained glass windows. It is hard to imagine an authentic Christianity that does not remember and honor the work of these two men.

They were both handpicked by Jesus for a very special role and then given the grace to fulfill their missions. In some part they didn't even know what role they played. To their knowledge they were sent to evangelize and lead Christian communities. Both were teachers, preachers and administrators. Both established local churches in various places. St. Paul was especially given the mission to evangelize to the Gentiles; bringing the message of salvation offered by the God of Israel to all. St. Peter was especially called to be a leader of the whole Christian community; to gather all of God's people into one flock. What they probably could not have known is that their actions would affect world history and billions of souls.

After lives of teaching, evangelizing, establishing churches, administering communities as bishops, and making critical decisions about the practices of the Church they both found themselves in Rome. Humanly speaking it would seem strange for them to go to Rome at this time. But traveling to Rome was like traveling to New York during its heyday. It was the capital of the world. This is why God would send these two men there, because from there the name of Jesus Christ would overcome the world. Though it would seem to observers at the time that they had failed when both were martyred in Rome around 67AD, today we know that they succeeded beyond their wildest imagining. As the late Cardinal George said after the election of Pope Benedict XVI, "Where is the successor of Caesar Augustus? Where is the successor of Marcus Aurelius? And finally, who cares? But if you want to see the successor of Peter, he is right next to me, smiling and waving at the crowds."

A feast like this helps us to remember that we do not always know what or why Christ calls us to the life we live. Often we will not even see the good fruit of what we do in this life. None the less we ought to remain faithful and confident that if we use the gifts given to us and always proclaim Christ by our lives, even if we die without seeing fruit, we will not have lived in vain. Sts. Peter and Paul changed the world by living and dying for Christ. We may be called to do the same.

Sts. Peter and Paul, pray for us.
