My name is Joe Bass, and I couldn't be happier to spend my summer here at Immaculate Conception. I am entering my fourth year of seminary formation, and will be ordained a deacon in two years- God willing! It is a particularly special gift for me to be here in Pointe Coupee parish, because this is the place I first considered a call to the priesthood of Jesus Christ. After graduating from LSU in 2011, I accepted a job at Catholic High School of Pointe Coupee as a Campus Minister, religion teacher, and I helped out where I could with baseball. It was during my two years at Catholic that I first experienced the joy of giving Christ to His children- and it was a blast! After work I could usually be found kayak fishing or bow fishing on False River or Old River, playing guitar on my back porch on Olinde Street, or introducing some of my buddies to the Pointe Coupee parish "good life." During my second year at Catholic, I realized that while my desire to be a husband and father were strong, God was asking me to "put out into deeper water," and give seminary a chance. After a time of prayer, I contacted the vocations director and applied for seminary. This was an exciting and somewhat frightening time, but each step I took was met with peace and assurance that God would not lead me into something that would not give me the joy He wills for each of us. I spent two wonderful years at St. Joseph's Seminary in Covington, and after graduation I spent a year at Mundelein Seminary in Chicago. My process of discernment has been a slow one, and I am thankful that God is patient. As I spend more time in seminary, I have become more and more confident that the life of a priest is not only something I could see myself living- it is one that I truly desire. Furthermore, I have learned that the life of a priest is not one of seclusion from the world. I used to think of the life of a priest as being boring and lonely. Now I realized that God desires to use the things we're passionate about to draw us closer to Him, and to draw others to Him through us. I'm passionate about my faith, about bringing Christ to His people, about the outdoors, about sports, about music, and about building strong relationships through which God reveals

himself. I am deeply thankful to be in seminary studying to be a priest, and I am thankful for the opportunity to come to know and love our Lord Jesus with each of you this summer. Keep me and my brothers in your prayers, and be assured of my prayers for you.
