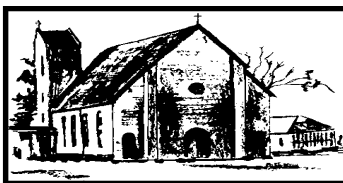

In Christ,

This Friday, the 29th of September, we will celebrate the feast of the Archangels, Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. And usually on the 2nd of October we celebrate the Guardian Angels, but won't this year because it falls on a Sunday. We are reminded by these feasts that we have spiritual companions to assist us in life.

The archangels have long been venerated in the tradition of the Church. Michael (meaning "Who is like God?") appears in both the Old and New Testament of the bible (Dan. 10:13, 21; 12:1; Jude 9; Rev. 12:7). He is the archangel who fights against Satan and all his evil angels, defending all the friends of God. He is the protector of all humanity from the snares of the devil.

Gabriel ("God is strong") is also present in both testaments of the bible. He is an interpreter of visions and a messenger (Dan. 8:16; 9:21; 8:15-26; 9:20-27; Luke 1:11-19; 26-38; 2:9; Acts 5:19, 8:26, 12:7). He is best known to Christians for his role of announcing to Zachariah the forthcoming birth of John the Baptist, and to Mary, the birth of Jesus. His greeting to the Virgin, "Hail, full of grace," is one of the most familiar and frequent prayers of the Christian people.

Finally, Raphael ("God Heals") is the archangel who took care of Tobias on his journey in the book of Tobit (5:12-15; 6:9-12; 6:15-17; 11:1-15; 12:15). He helps arrange a marriage, prescribes a means to ward off demons, and heals the blindness of Tobit. When he reveals his identity he says: "I am Raphael, one of the seven holy angels who present the prayers of the saints and enter into the presence of the glory of the Holy One" (Tob. 12:15). Naturally Raphael is revered as an angel of healing.

The belief in guardian angels is understood implicitly from scripture. From the Gospel of Matthew we read: "See that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I say to you that their angels in heaven always look upon the face of my heavenly

Father" (18:10). The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* states that "the existence of the spiritual, non-corporeal beings that Sacred Scripture usually calls 'angels' is a truth of faith" (328). From our birth until our death, man is surrounded by the protection and intercession of angels, particularly our guardian angel: "Beside each believer stands an angel as protector and shepherd leading him to life" (CCC, 336).

Remember to call on the help of the angels and offer your prayers to God through them. They are close to the throne of God and are created for only two purposes: to glorify God and assist us. What could be more encouraging in times of struggle than to remember that we have powerful, holy, and unique servants of God who are equipped to overcome any problem? Holy Angels of God, pray for us!
